On _____, the Ashwaubenon Municipal Court denied your motion for relief from judgment or determined that you were not indigent. Wisconsin Statute 800.14 provides that you have the right to appeal to the Brown County Circuit Court. If you decide to appeal, you **must** provide **written notice** of your decision to do so with the Ashwaubenon Municipal Court and the village attorney and pay the statutorily required appeal fees and costs within (twenty) **20 days** from the above date (if weekend/holiday, next business day). Time for filing an appeal cannot be extended by the municipal court judge.

You may satisfy all the statutory requirements for an appeal, by completing and filing this notice and the appropriate fees and costs with Ashwaubenon Municipal Court.

In this form of appeal, the court record will be sent for review to a Brown County Circuit Court Judge. The Circuit Court Judge will review the record and consider any exhibits that were introduced. Unless the Circuit Court Judge determines that the Municipal Court Judge’s determination was clearly erroneous, the decision will not be reversed.
