Informational Meeting
Habitat Restoration Project at Ashwaubenon Creek and Dutchman Creek

"The Village of Ashwaubenon, the National Railroad Museum, the City of Green Bay Parks Department, Brown County Parks Department, NEW Water (the brand of Green Bay's Metropolitan Sewerage District), the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, and Stantec are planning a habitat restoration project at Ashwaubenon Creek and Dutchman Creek. These areas have been identified as sites for fish and wildlife habitat improvement within the Lower Green Bay and Fox River Area of Concern. In addition to enhancing habitat, we are also exploring improvements to shoreline access as part of this planning. It is being funded through the Natural Resource Damage Assessment (NRDA) fund. We are looking for your input as we continue developing restoration plan options.

Please join us for a public input meeting at the National Railroad Museum on June 4, 2024. The meeting will be held at 6:30 PM at 2285 S Broadway, Green Bay, WI 54304. We will be presenting the project background, scope, and a conceptual plan for the park which will help to facilitate discussion.
