## Apples Never Fall

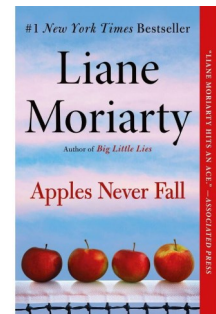
