WHEREAS, an adopted all hazards mitigation plan is required as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS, the County Board of Brown County has adopted the Brown County All Hazard Mitigation Plan as its official plan; and

WHEREAS, the **Village of Ashwaubenon** has reviewed such plan and recommends approval thereof for the **Village of Ashwaubenon**.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, upon approval of the *2026 Brown County All Hazards Mitigation Plan*, the Brown County Emergency Management Department will submit the adopted plan to Wisconsin Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency officials for final review and approval, as required under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.
