Dear Resident or Property Owner:

This is notification that your street is part of the 2026 Village of Ashwaubenon Asphalt Paving Program. This program will include:

- 1) Catch basin, manhole, water valve and curb & gutter repair, where necessary.
- 2) Milling the top 2" of existing asphalt pavement or pulverizing (*) of the entire asphalt roadway.
- 3) Repaving the roadway.

The 2026 Asphalt Paving Program includes the following streets:

Village crews along with Martell Construction, Inc. and DeKeyser Construction have started catch basin, manhole, water valve and curb & gutter work (curbing planned for replacement will be marked), and will continue into the month of July. If you have any underground facilities such as sprinkler systems or dog fencing, etc., please be aware that the Village is not responsible for items located in the road right-of-way. We ask that these facilities be moved prior to our work being done. Northeast Asphalt, Inc. is scheduled to start milling the above list of streets in late June. This schedule is based on favorable weather conditions and will adjust according to the weather. There will be no street closures or detours during any phase of the street improvements. If your driveway curbing is to be replaced, please have all vehicles out of driveways or garages to prevent an issue with using them and/or damaging the curb. Also, we ask that you avoid parking on the street during paving operations (approx. 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.) as much as possible, in order to facilitate the work and protect your vehicle. Contractors will notify you prior to impacting your curbing and street and give direction on parking.
