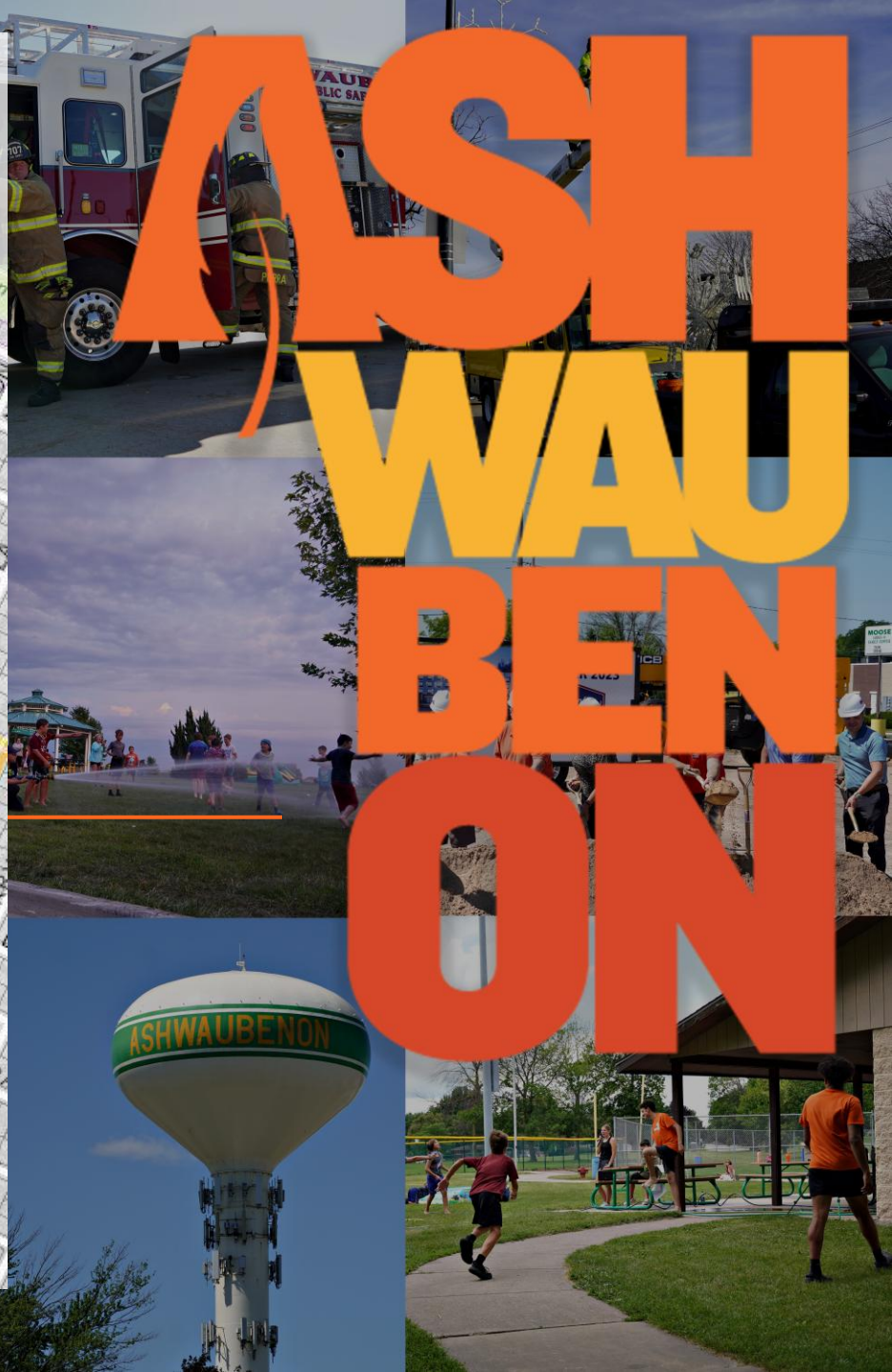

- Be sure to remove your vehicles from the garage/driveway and park on the south side of Cormier.
- If you have special access needs be sure to contact the Village to see what accommodations can be made.
- If you have a special event that the contractor shall be aware of please make project staff aware.

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# Project Safety

- Travel speed within the Project limits should be reduced
- Keep a distance from the heavy equipment as there is limited vision (if you can not see the operator, they can not see you)
- Be sure that you and your kids stay away from the equipment when parked or operating
