

Glory Rd Culvert Replacement Project (Culvert East of Commodity Ln.)

Project Information: The project replaces two large, corrugated metal culvert pipe that are located under Glory Rd, east of Commodity Ln, with a new reinforced concrete box culvert. To complete this work watermain work will be completed as some portions are in conflict with the culvert installation. The intent is to not turn any water services off but there may be a short timeframe when your water service needs to be shut off due to an unforeseen issue. Notifications will be sent out prior to any scheduled shut offs occurring. Construction is anticipated to begin in August with a tentative completion of early October, weather dependent.

Anticipated Timeline: Construction, August 2025 – Early October 2025

Road Closures, Vehicles & Traffic: While under construction, Glory Rd. will be closed between S. Ridge Rd. and Commodity Ln. Businesses that are on this portion of Glory Rd. will have access to their business but will only have access from the side of the culvert they are on. The designed detour route is to have traffic bypass the road closure using S. Ridge Rd to Ashwaubenon St to Commodity Ln back to Glory Rd. and vice versa.

Business Access: Access to and from your Business will be maintained as much as possible. Please let the Project Inspector or the Contractor know of any special provisions that may be needed to help you access your property.

Communication: It is the intent of the Village to minimize the amount of disruption and inconvenience to the community during any construction process. If during normal work hours you feel something went unnoticed, or needs attention, please contact **Matt Smith**. As project inspector, he is most familiar with the daily operations of construction and can resolve many issues quickly.

If something happens after normal work hours that you feel requires immediate attention, please call 920-492-2995, and arrangements will be made to resolve the issue. As always, in an emergency, please call 911. Additional information is available on the Village website.

Project Updates: Construction updates will be posted on the Village website bi-weekly, and when major changes will be occurring. If at any time you would like additional information, please contact any of the contacts listed on this page.

General Notes:

1. The Village is coordinating with mail carrier, and garbage/recycling pickup to ensure deliveries and pickups will not be affected by construction.
2. Please remove any irrigation, electric pet fences, landscaping, and other items within the Right-of-Way. This is your responsibility and not the Villages.

Two Week Anticipated Outlook:

Week of 9/8/25: Advance Construction is to continue installing the new concrete culvert sections. If all goes well and the culvert continues to arrive on time, the culvert installation should finish this week. Once the culvert is installed rip rap will be placed and the road will be stoned.

Week of 9/15/25: If the culver did not get finished the previous week it should be finished this week. If all goes to schedule and the weather cooperates. The concrete sidewalk and curb should be getting installed this week.
