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Introduction

A strategic plan is a top-level planning tool for an organization to establish clear policy direction over all operational aspects of its vision. The Strategic Plan serves as a framework for decision making over a five-year period. The plan is the result of a disciplined effort to facilitate decisions that will shape what the Village intends to accomplish. This plan incorporated an assessment of the present state of Village governance, the gathering of critical information, setting goals and finally making decisions for the future.

The Village of Ashwaubenon is experiencing a period of rapid change and significant growth. Changes in both the built environment and the organization have affected the availability of resources. At the same time, evolving service demands and changing societal expectations have increased the need for public services. As a result, the Ashwaubenon Village Board, staff, committees, and other decision-makers must maintain a shared understanding of priorities and clearly communicate the Village's strategic direction, key objectives, and action items.

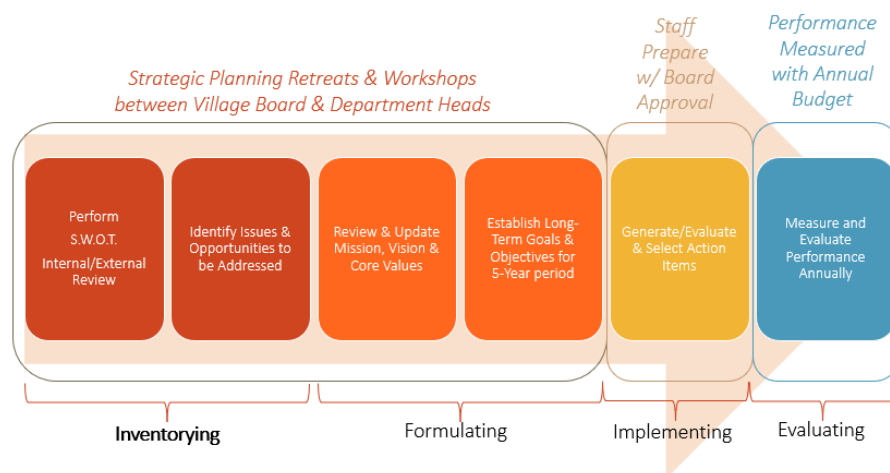
This Strategic Plan provides a framework for our agreed-upon vision, mission, and organizational core values. These foundational statements define what we want our community to be, our purpose as an organization, and how we will work together to achieve our goals.

Our Strategic Planning Process

The Village successfully developed and implemented its first Strategic Plan in 2021. Beginning in the fall of 2025 and continuing into early 2026, the Village Board and staff engaged in a new strategic planning process to guide the organization over the next five years.

In early 2026, the Village partnered with Allyson Brunette Consulting to assist with data collection, stakeholder engagement, and facilitation. Staff compiled and analyzed results from the 2025 Employee Experience Survey, the 2026 Community Resident Satisfaction Survey, stakeholder focus groups, and a Village Board/Executive Leadership Team retreat held in April 2026. Together, these efforts informed the development of the 2026-2031 Strategic Plan.

Strategic Planning Steps - Update



Employee Experience Survey

The Village's Human Resources Department conducts a biennial survey for employees to provide feedback on their workplace experiences. The survey is modeled largely after the Gallup Q12, a survey that measures four levels of employee needs, from basic clarity to personal growth. When these needs are met in sequence, they create a workplace where employees are highly engaged and motivated. The Appendix contains a summary from the 2025 Employee Experience survey. This plan includes a variety of initiatives and key action items relating to our internal organization and workforce. These action items are the direct result of the survey responses.

Resident Satisfaction & Quality of Life Survey

The Village conducted a resident survey to the public in February of 2026. This survey was conducted five years ago during the Village's first strategic planning process. This survey provides feedback to elected officials and village staff to improve the quality of life and the services we provide to our community. 730 individuals responded to the survey by the close of data collection in early March 2026. A summary of the resident survey results can be found in the Appendix.

Stakeholder Focus Groups

After conducting the resident satisfaction and quality of life survey, Allyson Brunette conducted three individual focus group sessions with residents and community stakeholders. A summary of the focus group conversations is included in the Appendix.

Justification of the Plan

Success isn't a matter of chance but rather a matter of choice. This concept really encapsulates why it's important to have a clear strategic direction and plan. If the Village isn't intentional about the direction of its services, we aren't likely to get there.

The importance of strategic planning is threefold.

1. *Our program of services will have better results.*
Setting broad key objectives with clear action orientated actions will enable the Village to have a clear direction and method for evaluating results.
2. *The strategic plan is the leading management tool.*
A strategic plan sets in motion the responsibilities, project timelines and funding budget expectations.
3. *The best organizations do it.*
High-performance organizations have fundamental differences that set them apart from other organizations. Communities that plan are more likely to be in better financial positions than those that don't.

Our Vision

"Ashwaubenon is a dynamic community of choice, leading northeast Wisconsin through opportunity, connection, and belonging."

A Reinstated Vision

The Village Board, in collaboration with key leadership staff, developed the revised Vision statement referenced above. The revised statement moves away from what Ashwaubenon has and moves it toward what Ashwaubenon is becoming; more action focused. It also refocuses more on people vs. tangible things or places. The new vision aligns directly to three "people-centered" questions our residents, employees and other stakeholders may ask when "choosing" Ashwaubenon: 1) Opportunity: Can I build a good life here? 2) Connection: Can I engage, participate, and be a part of something? 3) Belonging: Do I feel seen, valued and invested?

Our Mission

"To serve our community. Strengthening Ashwaubenon."

A Renewed Purpose

Our previous mission explained performance. The new mission expresses purpose. That makes the revised mission easier to remember, easier to repeat, and easier to use as a daily decision filter for elected officials, department leaders and general employees.

This statement aligns with the golden circle of "why." It identifies, in the simplest form, our contribution (to serve our community) and our contribution's impact (to strengthen Ashwaubenon). It also fits nicely on the back of a T-shirt!

The plan also identifies action steps, or tasks, associated with each initiative. These actions are the specific steps that will be taken to implement the initiative and move the Village toward achieving its goals.

Evaluation, Reporting, and Plan Adjustment

Periodic review and adjustment will be necessary throughout the planning period to ensure the Strategic Plan remains relevant, actionable, and aligned with the Village's priorities. Progress will be monitored through regular reporting, including quarterly Action Item Reports and reviews conducted as part of the annual budget process.

The quarterly Action Item Report will serve as a management tool to document progress on strategic initiatives, identify completed actions, highlight challenges or barriers, and outline next steps. This reporting process will provide the Village Board and the public with regular updates on implementation efforts and will help maintain accountability for achieving the Plan's objectives.

Performance measurement should identify specific, measurable outcomes for each strategic goal and objective to determine the extent to which desired results are being achieved. A balanced approach should be used when evaluating success, including:

- Service Delivery: What services or products were delivered, and to what extent?
- Citizen Satisfaction: How satisfied are residents, businesses, and other stakeholders with the services provided?
- Cost Efficiency: What resources were required to achieve the outcome, and were they used effectively?

The review process should evaluate progress toward achieving the Strategic Plan's goals while recognizing that many objectives are ongoing and may require multiple years to fully accomplish. As objectives, strategies, and action items are completed throughout the year, accomplishments should be documented through the quarterly reporting process. This documentation provides a clear record of implementation and allows for comparisons between planned actions and actual achievements.

When progress toward objectives is not meeting expectations, corrective action should be considered. Such actions may include modifying implementation strategies, adjusting timelines, reallocating resources, or revising objectives to reflect changing conditions, community needs, or organizational priorities.

Public evaluation and feedback can also play an important role in measuring success. Community surveys, stakeholder assessments, and other engagement efforts can provide valuable insight into public perceptions and priorities. If such tools are utilized, it is recommended that they begin after the second year of implementation to ensure sufficient progress has occurred and the community has had adequate exposure to the Plan's initiatives and outcomes.

This ongoing cycle of reporting, evaluation, and adjustment will help ensure the Strategic Plan remains a practical and effective guide for Village decision-making and service delivery throughout the planning period.

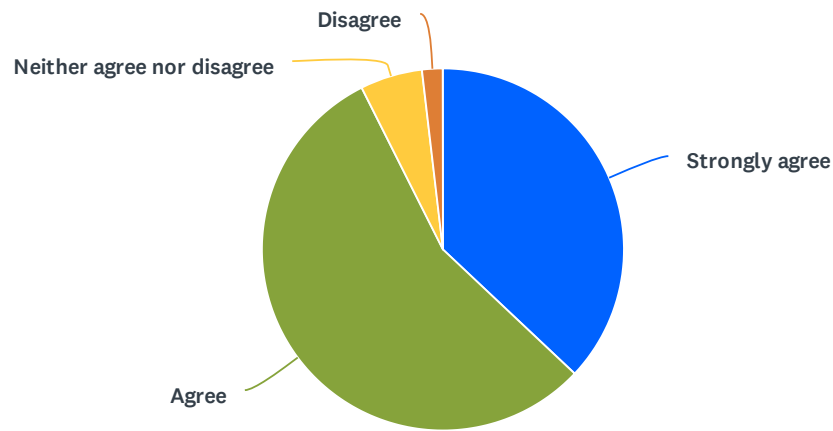

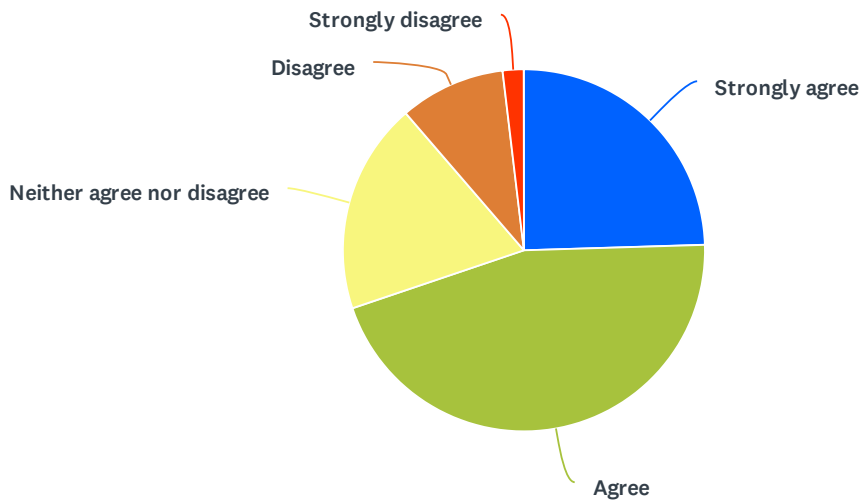

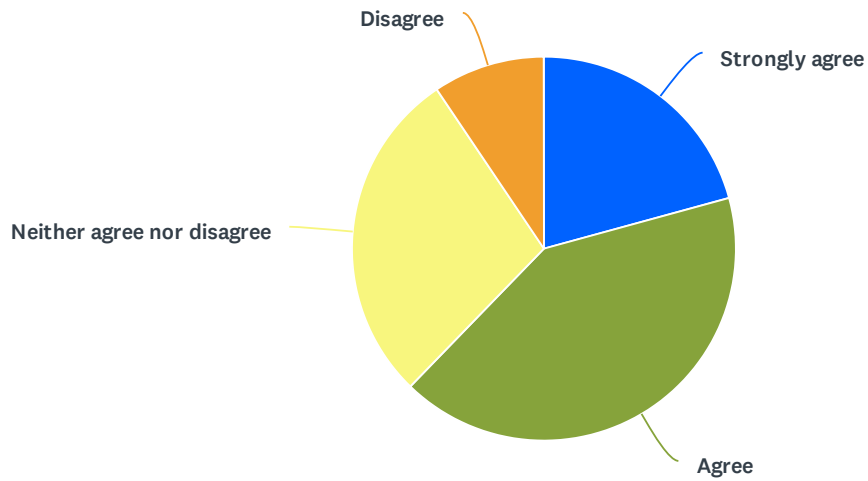
I have the training, materials, and equipment I need to do my work/job right.

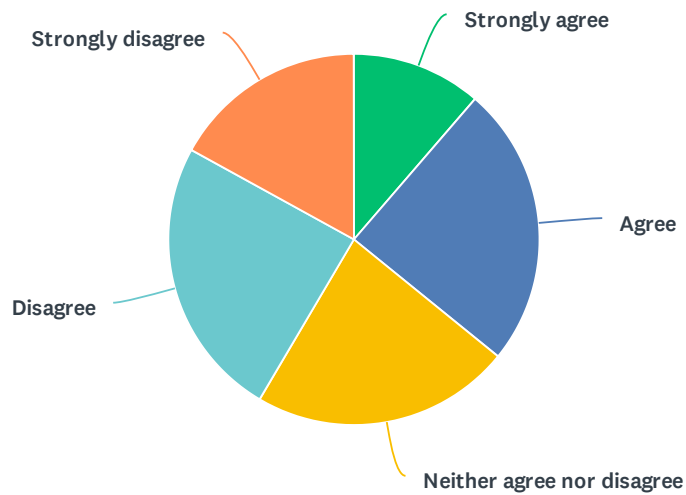
At work, I have the opportunity to do what I do best every day.

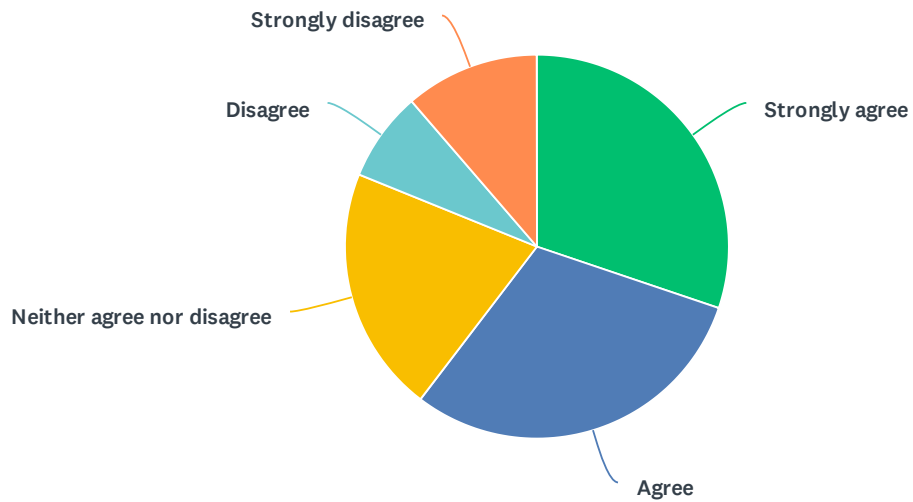
I have received some sort of sincere and specific praise or recognition in the last 7 days.

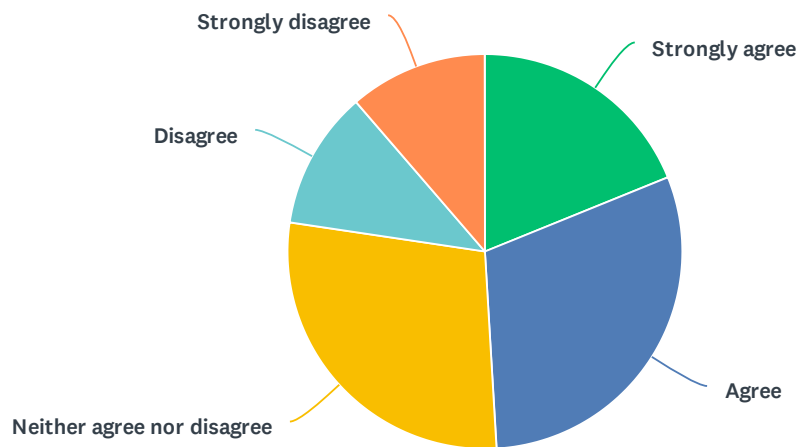
My supervisor, or someone at work, seems to care about me as a person.

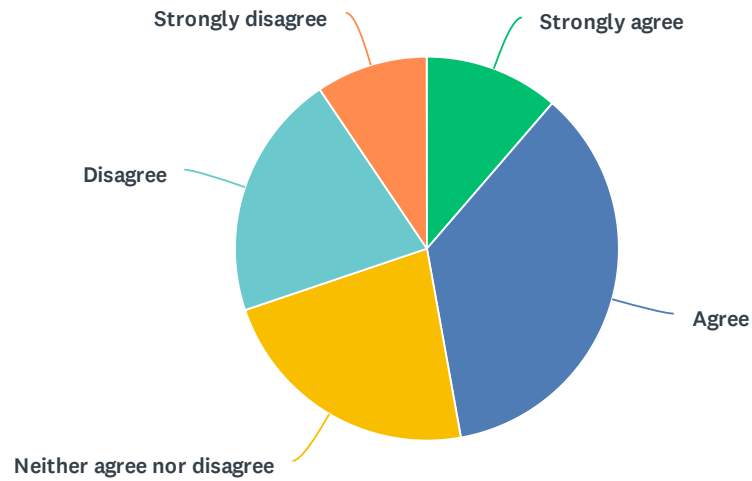
There is someone at work who encourages my professional development.

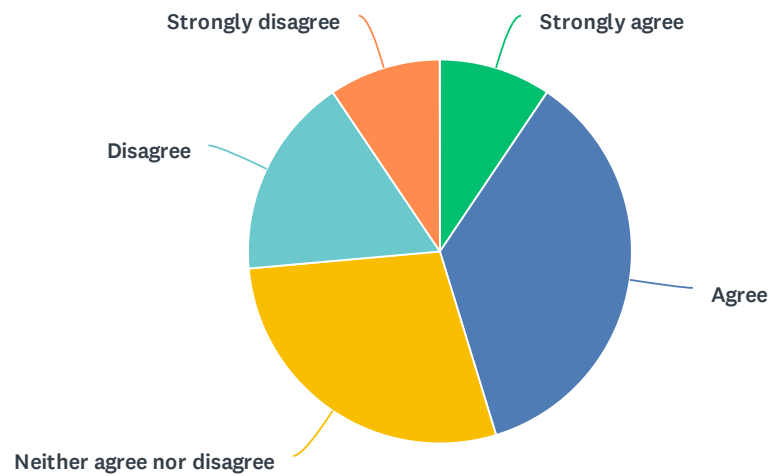
At work, my opinion matters.

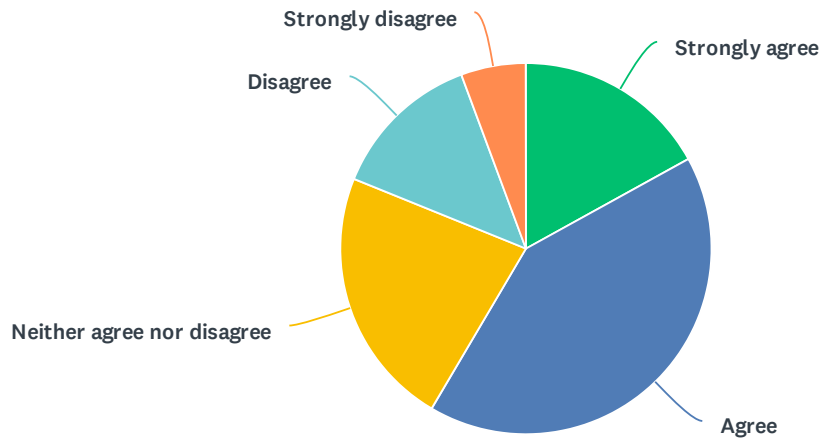
The organization's mission makes my work feel important.

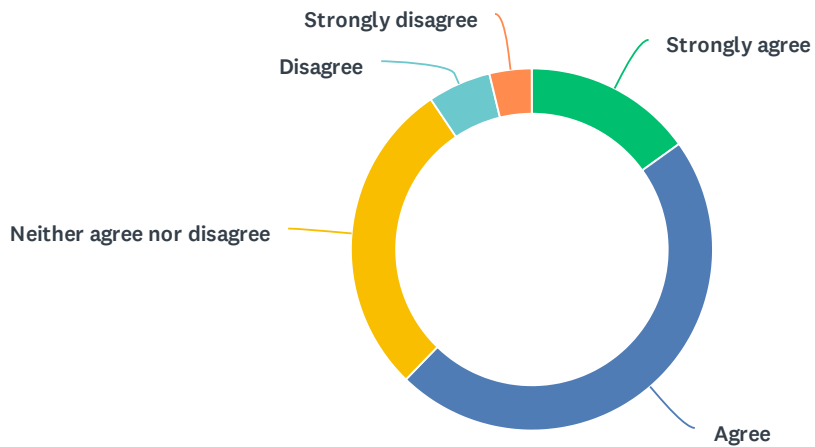
My co-workers are committed to doing their best work.

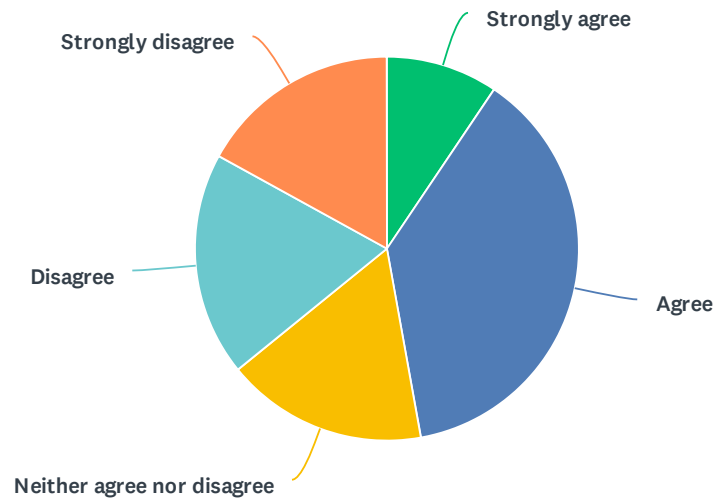
I have a close friend at work.

In the last 6 months, someone at work has talked to me about my progress.

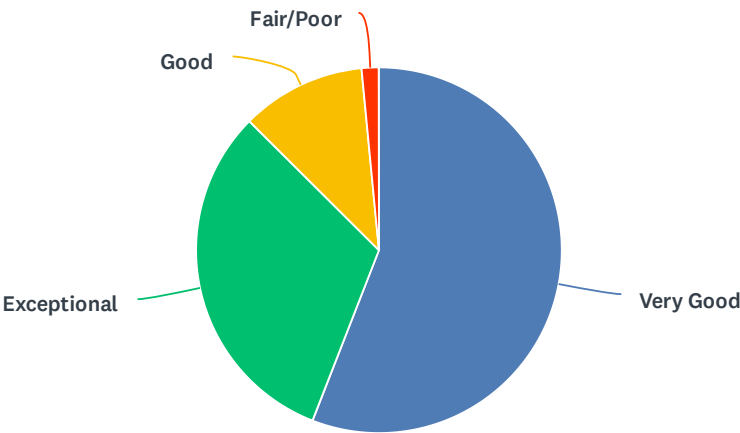

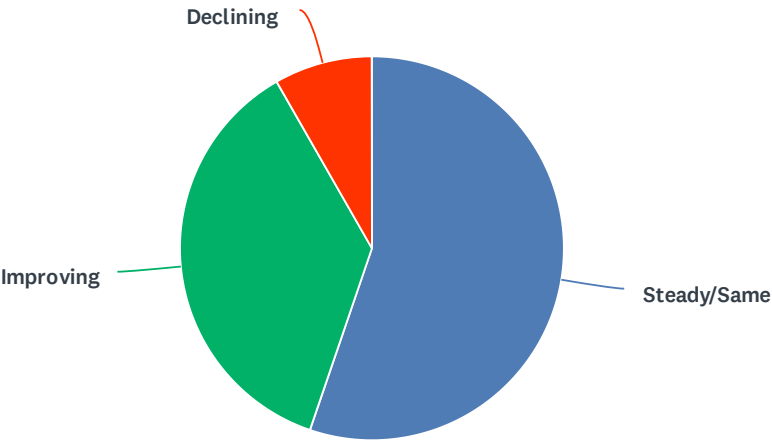

Q2 In your opinion, in which direction is Ashwaubenon headed?

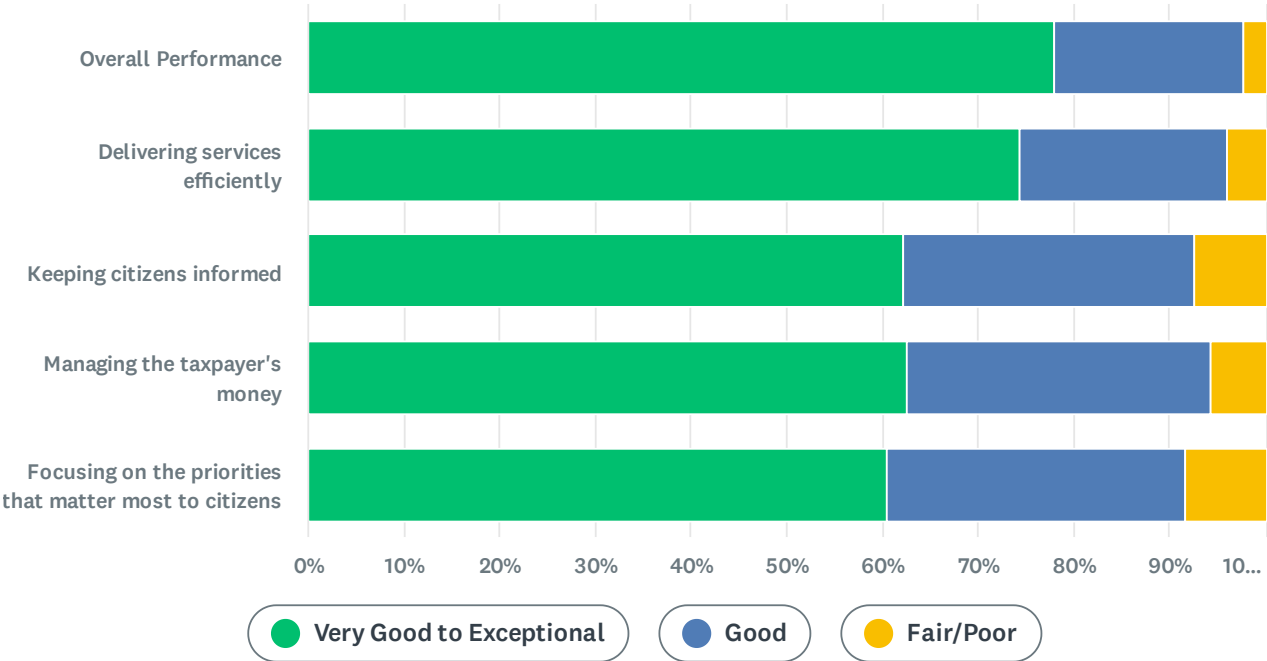

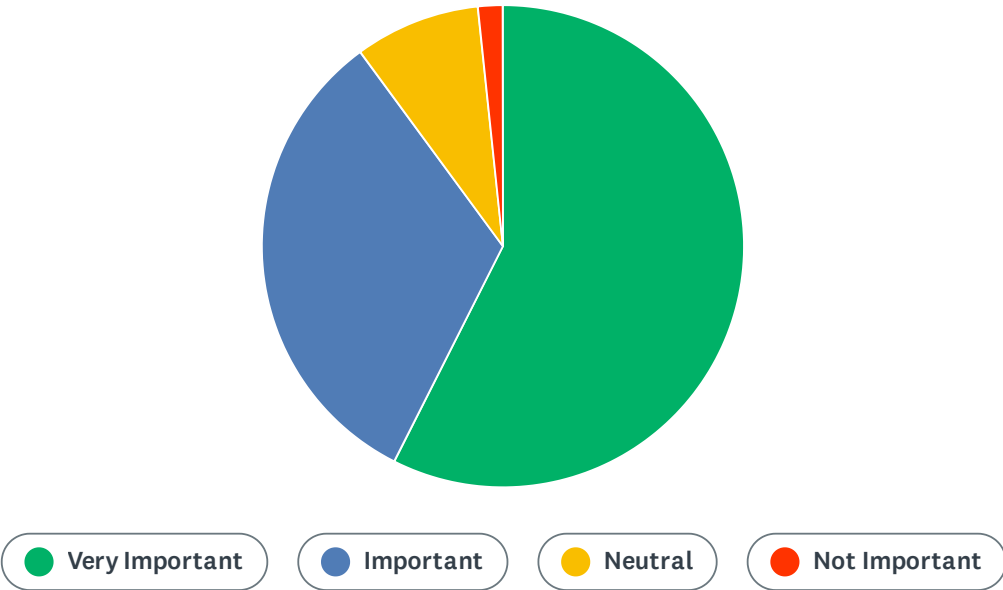

Q4 How important is attracting and keeping businesses in Ashwaubenon to you and your household?

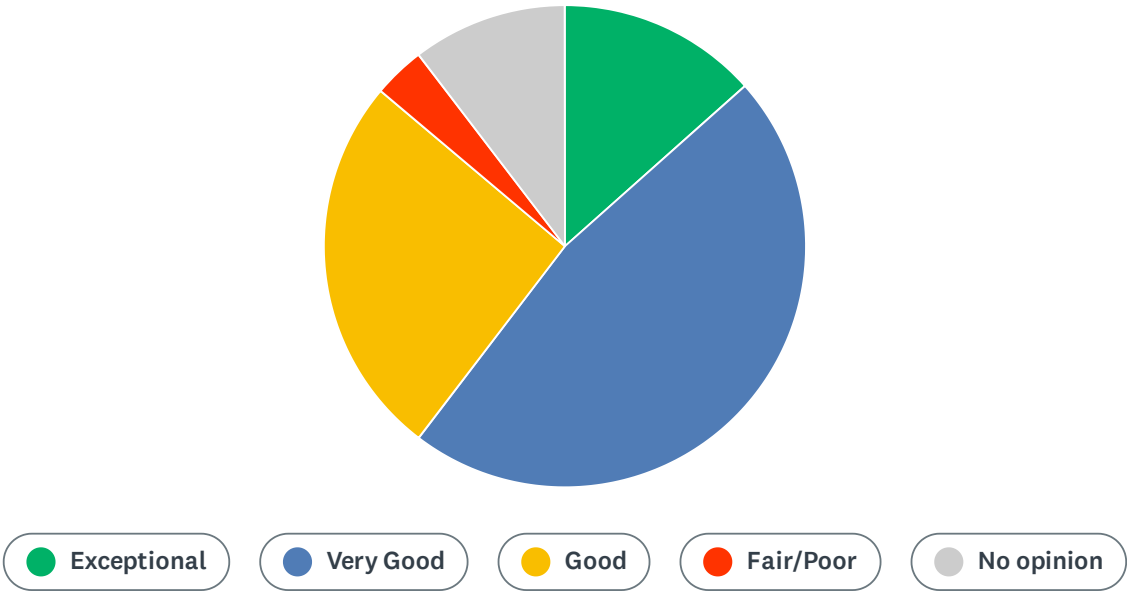

Q5 How well does the Village of Ashwaubenon do in attracting and keeping businesses?

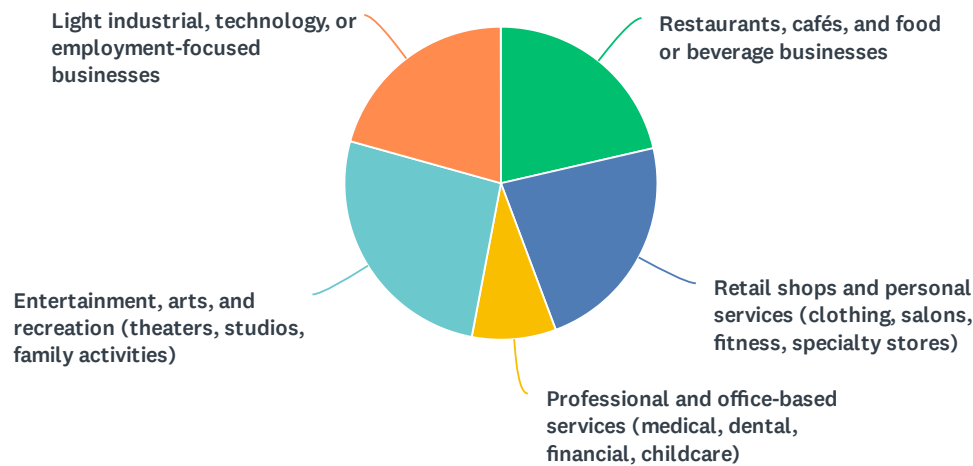

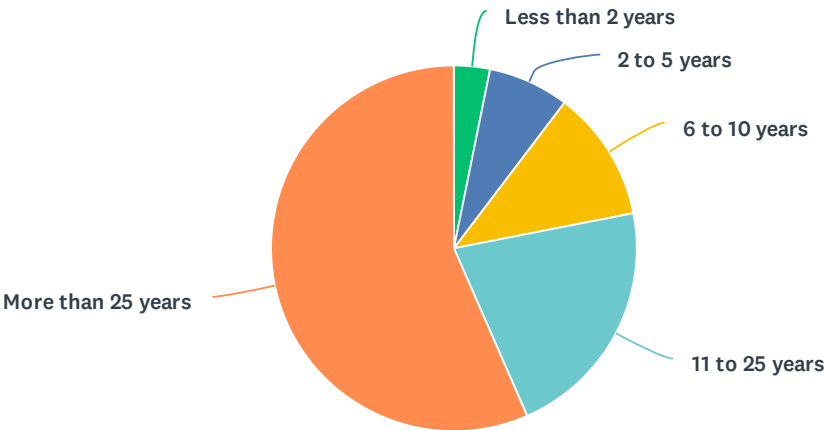

APPENDIX C – Community Survey Results

Themes from VOA Focus Groups by department area in SOAR Format:

- Four, 90-minute focus groups held in March 2026 at Community Center at varying times
- 29 attendees across the four
- Attendees included new and multigenerational residents, employees of major organizations, retirees, small business owners – majority were retirees – three attendees in 30s/40s.
- Parents, grandparents, former coaches, educators of students in ASD
- Many have lived in several homes in Ashwaubenon during their time here
- Little representation of Ashland Ave / Broadway corridors – more so north and west of Ashland with some representation from Sand Acres Drive area.

Public Safety:

Strengths -

- Pleased with the first responder cross-training, feel that we have highly professional officers. Love knowing that no matter who arrives when you call 911, they're qualified to help in all three areas. Realize it may make recruitment challenging, but don't want to lose that.
- Feel extremely safe in the Village

Opportunities –

- Clarify and communicate ordinance rules around E-bikes and motorized scooters. Use by youth is reckless.
- Want clarity on the ordinance change – can you ride on the sidewalk? Do you have to wear helmets? How fast can you go? What about adults who own these? What are the rules for them? Can this be included in an upcoming community guide?
- Mixed sentiments on public safety response – some want ticketing, others want positive policing. Worry about deadly accidents with youth – feel that police intervention is more effective than parent intervention at times.
- Opportunity for positive policing? Example: A coupon for free ice cream if you are wearing a helmet. Like the Frogger initiative in Green Bay. Recommend more bike rodeo-type events with a big prize giveaway – a positive awareness campaign around helmets and rules.
- Would like to see more bicycle patrols through residential neighborhoods and more positive impressions of police by youth,

- Police vehicles that are all “blackout” and not visibly a police car are scary to kids – can be confusing if one is speeding without lights – is it a police vehicle or an individual vehicle?
- Increase traffic enforcement around speeding (near Argonne Park, Marlee Lane, Cormier, Shady, Circle Dr, Packerland, Morris, near Waterford Park, Hansen Road, Oneida Street)
- Fireworks a concern – dogs, public safety, fear of fires

Aspirations –

- Stronger connectivity between neighborhoods, reducing barriers created by major roads
 - Better safety for bicyclists and pedestrians: Oneida Street, Cormier (sidewalks on both sides), Babcock/172 intersection, Pioneer and Carole,
 - Ashland Avenue (need better, safe connectivity to Ashwaubomay and the trail system)
 - Pedestrian bridge or tunnel connectivity to connect the four quadrants of the Village – the goal would be to connect Pioneer Park and High School. Maintain Park and school connectivity between neighborhoods. This would be great future planning for when the elderly turn over, and our community fills up with young families.
- Streets that are safe for all users – drivers, pedestrians, bicyclists
 - Roundabouts requested: Cormier and Shady, Grant and Sand Acres
 - Better visibility / blind spot resolution: Cormier and Shady, apartments on Holmgren
- A proactive, visible, and community-oriented Public Safety presence
 - Request more permanent mount speed check signs
 - Okay with speed or red light cameras if legalized
- A community where youth mobility is safe and well-regulated, with a shared understanding of the rules.

Results –

- Reduction in speeding and reckless driving
- Fewer incidents involving youth on e-bikes/scooters
- Increased compliance with safety rules

- Safer ped crossings and improved walkability
- Positive community-police engagement

Public Works:

Strengths –

- High satisfaction with core services (Excellent snow removal, leaf collection, spring/fall cleanup, garbage collection, street maintenance)
- Appreciate that the Village has vacuum trucks so that bagging leaves is not necessary, compost site with free dirt, mulch
- Excellent customer service from garbage crews – get out of the truck, circle back if necessary
- High rate of responsiveness - commend the Village on addressing a fallen tree quickly after winter storm
- High quality infrastructure - “When you cross jurisdictions into Green Bay, you can tell the difference”. Appreciate foresight around street replacement.

Opportunities -

- Simplify and better communicate bulk pickup processes:
 - Please never get rid of bulk pickup – understand the reasons for the change
 - Questioned why there is a volume limit
 - If rental properties consistently put out large quantities of waste, they should be billed for it
 - Some dislike the in-advance registration – understand the efficiencies but want to just be able to put it out like they used to.
- Enhance seasonal waste services:
 - Could ONE winter bulk pickup be scheduled? It’s hard keeping bulk items indoors in your garage all winter – maybe schedule it and then keep it

tentative if weather won't allow for it? Could it be placed on driveway apron rather than on grass?

- Request additional recycling pick up around Christmas – too many boxes from deliveries!
- Clarify around brush pickup processes:
 - Wish there was no volume limitation on brush – the Village has the equipment and should pick it all up at no additional cost
 - Confusion around disposal of Christmas trees – technically it's yard waste “not generated by your yard” – need better verbiage
- Concern around unsafe pavement conditions near RR crossing. Know the village isn't responsible, but please continue to stay on top of RR. Noted Cormier RR crossing especially near school.
- Village could be more responsible around street tree trimming, BUT credit due that when they do trim trees they clean up as though they never were there (unlike WPS who leave a mess behind)

Aspirations –

- A system that is easy to understand, convenient, and resident-friendly
- Continued reputation as a best-in-class public works provider
- Seamless, predictable services that reduce resident confusion

Results –

- Increased resident understanding of service rules and schedules
- Reduced complaints or confusion about bulk pickup
- High participation and satisfaction across all waste and recycling programs

Parks/Recreation:

Strengths –

- Appreciate the quality of the parks / how well taken care of they are / Love seeing the updates made to parks and equipment / Appreciate walking trails at Ashwaubomany, Sherwood Forest

- Like how parkies run programming and appreciate this as a first job opportunity for youth / Rec sports are excellent
- Appreciate community events in the summer (Ashwaubomay, Klipstine summer concert series, swimming lessons at Community Pool, movies in the park)
- Love the Community Center and programming held there

Opportunities -

- No sidewalks near parks is a disadvantage – especially near Smith Park – Shady Lane feels unsafe
- Would love to have something like a Y or Kroc Center with kid offerings. Western Racquet and Ashwaubenon Y (is that De Pere or Ashwaubenon?) do not have kid camps. Wish for an indoor recreation area that is free for young kids in winter especially
- Desire a dog park
- Enhance environmental practices: Would like to see urban orchards, fewer chemicals used on grass in parks, tree canopy restoration
- Reevaluate amenities like sand volleyball courts in parks, they're never used
- Possible opportunity for more community beautification through volunteer program like De Pere, Allouez with planters, garden beds. Discussed more banners and possibly veteran recognition. Reinforce feeling of community.

- Would like to see term limits for Village Trustees – some don’t know when to hang it up
- Continue strengthening transparency and accountability

Aspirations –

- A local government that remains approachable, accountable, and trusted
- Continued reputation as a partner to residents and businesses

- Sustained high levels of resident and business satisfaction
- Continued engagement and trust in local leadership
- Clear, transparent decision-making processes

Finance:

- Regional assets make us distinct as a metro:
 - Appreciate the Packers and their investment in the area
 - Titledown is amazing, something to be proud of
 - Christmas lights are beautiful, love taking kids to programs.

Opportunities –

- Address housing gaps, including:
 - Future ability of our grandchildren to afford housing in community
 - Individuals who want to downsize out of their fully paid off homes but can’t justify the cost of new built homes are stuck.
 - Want to have appropriate housing to keep elderly community members here.
 - Flip side perspective from a younger family - we can’t afford to upsize to a larger home “even though we’re bursting at the seams”
 - How can our zoning codes enable higher density “missing middle” housing somewhere in between single family and apartments?
 - Some mixed sentiments around volume of apartments being built - do not want low income housing, too many people in one property. Worry about apartments contributing to more transiency (people moving in and out of the

community – no established sense of community), How are greenspace requirements being met in apartments?

- Love Titledown, but frustrated that 60 homes were removed by the Packers – the housing built within the Titledown District “isn’t for us”
- Develop strategies to manage and further restrict short-term rentals:
 - Don’t want anymore of them in the community – negatively impacting affordable housing
 - Don’t want corporations who own many Airbnbs in Ashwaubenon
 - Complaints about individuals renting on social media vs. through Airbnb / VRBO which are unregulated and unenforced
 - Can permits be limited to near the stadium? Feel unsafe with largely vacant properties in neighborhoods.
- Revitalize underutilized commercial corridors and vacant properties:
 - Apartments on Oneida Street with the flags that are Airbnbs next to Lambeau
 - vacant lot where Hardees was (should not be a Bergstrom lot, It’s too high value!)
 - Asheville Court - It’s a bad look on game days for people to walk down this section of Oneida street – looks “dismal”
 - Old North Shore Bank
 - open spots in the strip mall near Five Guys – this is prime property off the highway
 - Could the mostly vacant strip mall across from Village Hall be purchased and turned into an interactive greenspace?
 - Would like to see focus on filling vacant buildings on Waube and Ridge – Is there room for more commercial activity there like a coffee shop, accessible to neighborhoods off of Waube?
- Support residents navigating housing transitions and financial planning
 - Need more resources to help seniors navigate the decision and financial planning of moving out of their homes – could there be ADRC resources or lunch topic around this at Community Center?
 - See it as a major issue that established residents aren’t “giving up their homes” for young families, but where are they going to go?
 - Would like to see a liaison from ADRC come and have face time available with residents at Community Center or in new library branch. Residents don’t want to drive to downtown Green Bay, Howard or East De Pere Libraries for those services.
- Strengthen balanced code enforcement practices - there have been more homes that have trashy front yards. People who don’t cut grass all summer. Don’t want to

live in a community where the government is over-enforcing, but must follow up on code enforcement on a case-by-case basis.

Aspirations –

- A community with housing options for all life stages
- Vibrant corridors that reflect community pride and economic vitality
- A balanced approach to growth that preserves character while welcoming new investment
- A stable, connected community with long-term residents and strong neighborhoods

Results –

- Increased availability of diverse, attainable housing options
- Reduction in negative impacts from short-term rentals
- Activation of key commercial areas (near Lambeau Field, I-41 Oneida St exit, Waube Rd up to 41) and reduction in commercial vacancies
- Strong neighborhood stability and maintenance

 - Some feel law enforcement should ticket for loitering. Okay with individuals hanging out in public spaces, but not if panhandling.
 - Worries about any other facilities that may encourage continued homelessness in Village.
 - Do not want to see encampments.
 - Law enforcement should be humane in dealing with people.
 - Empathy expressed for people experiencing homelessness in Ashwaubenon on Oneida Street. Fear of scammers.
 - Need a unified approach on how surrounding municipalities address panhandling.
 - Discussed signage to discourage panhandling
 - Direct funding to regional non profits as an option or village-funded social worker
 - We are a sought-after, family-friendly community. Focus on maintaining this.

- Like new developments on Holmgren but worry about convenience of parking (Capital Credit Union Park) – don't want to become Madison where parking is a bear
- Would community ever support expanded public transportation? Group not aware around GB Metro ride services – need more publicity of this. Our aging population deserves better options for transportation.
- Would like one day off from mowing engines and power equipment
- Village doesn't enforce the rule of "garbage cans not being visible to the street" – really lax on this.

Opportunities from VOA Focus Groups by Strategic Plan Directive Areas

Directive 1 – Enhance Quality of Life

1. Plan, develop, improve, and maintain Village’s QOL assets, both public and private:
 - a. Improve safe access and connectivity to parks and amenities (sidewalk gaps, crossings, trail connections)
 - b. Expand year-round recreational infrastructure, including indoor options for youth and families.
 - c. Enhance environmental quality of parks and public spaces (tree canopy restoration, reduced chemical use, urban orchards).
 - d. Evaluate and modernize underutilized park amenities.
2. Build and strengthen relationships with neighborhood organizations and diverse community groups:
 - a. Develop community-led beautification and placemaking initiatives (volunteer programs, planters, banners, recognition efforts).
 - b. Expand local access to services for aging residents (ADRC presence in Village spaces)
 - c. Create more opportunities for neighborhood-level engagement and identity-building.
3. Support and enhance recreational, entertainment, and cultural opportunities throughout the Village:
 - a. Expand family-oriented and youth programming, especially during the winter months.
 - b. Enhance community events and gathering spaces to reinforce belonging and identity.
 - c. Explore opportunities for new recreation models (rec center, Y, dog park)

Directive 2 – Secure Public Health and Safety

1. Protect lives and property through timely and effective public safety response:
 - a. Increase visibility and consistency of traffic enforcement in high-risk corridors.
 - b. Address high-risk intersections and pedestrian safety gaps.
2. Enhance crime prevention, community policing, and code enforcement:
 - a. Clarify and communicate rules for e-bikes, scooters, and ATVs, including youth usage.

- b. Expand community-oriented policing strategies including youth engagement and education programs.
 - c. Strengthen balanced code enforcement practices (property maintenance, neighborhood standards)
 - d. Evaluate visibility and recognizability of police vehicles to build trust, especially among youth.
- 3. Improve the Village's ability to manage and recover from disruptive or disaster-related events:
 - a. Develop a more coordinated, regional approach to homelessness and panhandling, balancing compassion and enforcement.
 - b. Explore integration of social services into public safety response through social worker model or nonprofit partnerships.
- 4. Enhance environmental sustainability and resiliency:
 - a. Address concerns related to fireworks, noise, and environmental impacts.
 - b. Continue strengthening urban forestry.

Directive 3 – Improve and Maintain Public Infrastructure and Facilities

- 1. Improve our roads & highways, pedestrian, bike, and transit infrastructure:
 - a. Improve walkability and bike safety across major corridors (Oneida, Cormier, Ashland)
 - b. Enhance connectivity between neighborhoods currently divided by highways
 - c. Evaluate traffic calming strategies (roundabouts, speed feedback signs, future technologies)
 - d. Increase awareness and explore expansion of public transit options, especially for aging population.
- 2. Improve and effectively maintain our water, sanitary, and stormwater management services and infrastructure:
 - a. N/A
- 3. Improve and effectively maintain our Village-owned facilities
 - a. Ensure facilities support (recreation, community center)

Directive 4 – Support Community and Economic Development

- 1. Attract, expand, and retain business and workforce:
 - a. Continue to diversify the economy with knowledge-based jobs
 - b. Ensure Village remains business-friendly and easy to work with

2. Support redevelopment opportunities for key districts, underutilized properties, and along commercial corridors:
 - a. Prioritize revitalization of underutilized and high-visibility properties (Oneida Street corridor near Lambeau, vacant lots, aging strip malls)
 - b. Explore placemaking and/or adaptive reuse strategies
 - c. Improve visual quality and perception of key corridors
3. Strive to expand and create new quality, diverse housing options:
 - a. Address gaps in housing across life stages including:
 - i. Downsizing options for seniors
 - ii. Entry-level and move-up housing for families
 - b. Explore zoning and policy tools to enable missing middle housing
 - c. Develop strategies to manage and limit short-term rentals, especially corporate ownership
 - d. Support residents with housing transition planning and resources (financial, educational, ADRC partnerships)

Directive 5 – Strive for Organizational and Financial Excellence

1. Optimize organizational structure and human resource management:
 - a. Evaluate term limits for Village Board
2. Implement operating efficiencies and technology improvements:
 - a. Simplify and improve service delivery systems (bulk pickup processes, registration systems)
 - b. Balance operational efficiency with resident convenience and expectations
3. Expand and improve our performance management and reporting systems:
 - a. Improve communication and transparency around:
 - i. Tax structure and increases
 - ii. TIF districts and development impacts
 - iii. External cost drivers like school referendums
 - b. Develop more accessible, user-friendly financial communication tools

Directive 6 – Provide Effective Communication and Engagement

1. Maximize the use of electronic communication to provide comprehensive, timely, and accurate information:
 - a. Improve clarity and accessibility of information on:
 - i. Ordinance changes (e-bikes, scooters)

- ii. Public Works Processes (bulk pickup, yard waste)
 - b. Expand use of community guides and digital communication tools
- 2. Market/brand the Village and increase exposure through effective multimedia campaigns and special events:
 - a. Reinforce identity as a family-friendly, high-quality community
 - b. Leverage regional assets (Tittletown, Packers, events) in branding and storytelling
- 3. Maintain collaborative relationships with other public/education/government entities and private service providers:
 - a. Strengthen partnerships with:
 - i. ADRC and social service providers
 - ii. Regional municipalities (around a coordinated homelessness approach)
 - iii. Transit providers to improve awareness and access

Opportunities that did not fit neatly into Strategic Plan Directives:

- *Managing community growth while preserving ease of living (don't want to see parking become too difficult near Capital Credit Union Park)*
- *Housing system imbalance across life stages (complex systems issue)*
- *Community expectations around enforcement vs. compassion with individuals currently experiencing homelessness (Village needs to have a policy position and likely unify with surrounding municipalities)*
- *Everyday livability and neighborhood standards (desire for one day of no mowing, fireworks concerns, want garbage cans to not be visible from the street)*
